People's Republic of China	500 points out of 750 points according to the grading system of the programme applied to in the Central University Entrance Exam and 12 years of High School Diploma (Senior Secondary School Certificate) grade must be a minimum of 80 %
Indonesia	50 points out of 60 in the exam "Ujian Nasional (UN)"
Morocco	13/20 GPA in Human Sciences, and a minimum of 15/20 GPA in other fields
Palestine	80 % success related to the area in the programme applied for in the Central High School Completion Test

Japan	Japanese 80 (200 points), Social Sciences 1 Subject area 60 (100 points), 2 Subjects areas 130 (200 points). History – Geography, Civil Rights, Foreign Languages 80 (200 points) from the Fields of Japan Daigaku Nyūski Senta Shiken Entrance exam, Highest points and duration.
Qatar	80 % in an area related to the programme applied for in the Central High School Completion Test
Kazakhstan	75 points out of 100 in the four main parts of the National University Entrance Exam (ENT), not including the language exam, which assesses language different than the high school medium of instruction (Russia or Kazakh)
Kenya	B+; also required to receive 44 points out of at least four fields in the programme applied for, from the average score of the exam KCSE (Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education)
Kyrgyzstan	185 points out of 250 in the National University Entrance Exam (ORT)
Kuwait	80% success from the Central High School Completion Test in related areas of the programme applied for
Liberia	21 points in five subject areas, from the “West African Examination Council– (International) Senior School Certificate Examination (WAEC – SSCE)” three of which must be related to the programme applied for
Libya	80 % from the Central High School Completion Test in an area related to the programme applied for
Lebanon	15/20 GPA in General Sciences, and a minimum of 13/20 GPA in other fields
Macedonia	3 out of 5 in the Central High School Completion Test (Matura)

Malaysia	A-B-B from 3 subject areas in the Sijil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia (STPM). Two of these three subject areas should be related to the department being applied for
Matura	75 % of the full GPA
Egypt	80 % in the National High School Exit Exam, in the subject area related to the department applied for

Syria	80 % in the National High School Exit Exam, in the subject area related to the department applied for
Saudi Arabia	90% for the department applied for and also, his/her “Qudurat” score should be at least 80%
Tanzania	Freshman Diploma Requirements: “General Studies” must have 9 points in three principal level subject areas. The applicant must be Division One in the related subject area of the Tanzanian Advanced Certificate Of Secondary Education-ACSE.
