

Required Application Documents

- Graduation Certificate (Diploma) or an Official Temporary Graduation Certificate (For documents issued abroad, a notarized Turkish or English translation must be provided.)
- Official Transcript of Records (For documents issued abroad, a notarized Turkish or English translation must be provided.)
- Diploma Equivalency Certificate (The requirement to submit this document at the application stage varies by program.)
- Two signed Letters of Recommendation (preferably issued within the last nine months).
- Statement of Purpose
- Valid passport
- Biometric photograph
- Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- School Recognition Certificate (Applicants who graduated from a university abroad, must submit a document certifying that the university is recognized by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK). Applicants without access to e-Government services may obtain the relevant document through the International Office.)
- English Language Proficiency (Applicants to English-taught programs must demonstrate English language proficiency by obtaining a minimum score of 80 on the YDS, e-YDS, or YÖKDİL exams, or an equivalent score on a foreign language exam recognized by the Council of Higher Education, YÖK.)
- Turkish language Proficiency (Applicants to Turkish-taught programs must submit a C1-level Turkish Language Proficiency Certificate from TÖMER, DİLMER or TYS. Applicants who have completed their undergraduate or

graduate education at an institution where the language of instruction is Turkish are exempt from this requirement.)

NOTES:

- There is no English language proficiency requirement applies to non-thesis master's programs.
- Applicants to the Turkish-taught programs are also required to meet the English language proficiency requirement set by the respective program.
- Depending on the specific program, applicants to master's or PhD programs may be invited to an interview by the Evaluation Committees.
